

## **Childcare and Youth Options offered during Mission Summit/Biennial**

**Pre-registration will be required for the Infant/Toddler Room, Children's Center, Younger Youth Day Camp and Older Youth Extreme Overnight Camp.**

**No on-site registrations will be accepted. Once you register, additional forms/information will be sent to you in the coming weeks by the Local Arrangements Committee.**

### **Infants/Toddlers**

Ages 0 – 3 years old

A program including a nurturing environment and activities are being developed by the Local Arrangements Committee.

### **Children's Center**

Ages 4 – 7 years old

The Local Arrangements Committee are developing a fun-filled day for your child. This group will participate in Vacation Bible School-like activities. Play clothes preferable as activities may include indoor and outdoor activities, weather pending.

### **Younger Youth "Day" Camp**

Ages 8 – 12 years old

Elementary grades welcome for those entering 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grade. Through activities, a mission experience, possible off-site activities (which may include a water park, LEGOLAND or the Aquarium), transportation included, this group will experience greater Kansas City, accompanied by adult volunteer and youth ministers from the Central Region. Departure each morning will be from the Overland Park Convention Center with a return early evening in time to share dinner with family.

### **Older Youth "Extreme" Camp**

Ages 13 – 17 years old

The Extreme Camp has become a popular mission experience for youth in the Central Region. This event welcomes those entering 7<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. The Extreme Camp includes overnight accommodations for Friday and Saturday night. Transportation will be provided with a departure from the Overland Park Convention Center Friday morning and a return on Sunday evening. Youth will have the opportunity to work, volunteer and play. Destinations for this mission will be kept secret however, prior details will be made known to youth and parents so appropriate items can be packed. The Central Region youth pastors and volunteers will be providing this opportunity.
